New Forest Kayak & Canoe Club — Application for Membership & Membership Renewal

Classes of Membership

- Full Member — over the age of 18 on joining
- Junior Member — under the age of 18 on joining

Note: Juniors under the age of 12 on joining will only be accepted if one or both parents/guardians are also members and they must expect to accompany the child on the water at all times, or be present on the poolside during pool sessions (Note: This is not required when the NFKCC is running a 'try-out' or 'taster' session or during specific, coached, training sessions).

Cost of Membership

- Full Member — £30 (Plus £2.50 for non-BCU members)
- Junior Member — £15 (Plus £2.50 for non-BCU members)

Note: Non-BCU (British Canoe Union) members are required to pay an additional £2.50 to cover the cost of affiliation with the BCU for 3rd party liability insurance, river access licences, etc., whilst on club activities.

Limitation of liability

Outdoor activities may carry attendant risks. Participants should be aware of and accept these risks and be responsible for their own action and involvement. Upon acceptance into membership of the New Forest Kayak and Canoe Club (NFKCC) you understand that kayaking and canoeing is undertaken at your own risk.

It is a condition of membership that the club itself cannot be held responsible for any accident, injury, loss or damage caused by or sustained by any member or visitor to the club or their property on any occasion, however caused. Parents/guardians of junior members must also accept this limitation of liability. However, as an affiliated club, all NFKCC club members are individually covered by the British Canoe Union (BCU) liability insurance policy.

Restrictions

A person who has been expelled from, or refused membership of, the British Canoe Union (BCU), shall not be eligible for membership.

Pool Sessions

The NFKCC holds regular pool sessions during the winter months and ad-hock sessions the rest of the year at a local school pool. The cost of the pool sessions is in addition to normal membership fees — at the time of writing these are £10 for a two hour session (£5 for juniors). We work in pairs to help improve general boat handling skills and to learn and develop bracing and rolling techniques. The sessions are limited to twelve participants and should be booked through the club secretary (info@nfkcc.org.uk).

Please do not just show up to pool sessions without contacting the club secretary, as you may find the session is full and you won't get a chance to paddle.

Personal Information
